Effective Sunday, Sept. 15, the Medical-Renal unit (3B) at Greenville Memorial Hospital will transition to a Neuroscience Med/Surg unit. Neuro diagnoses cared for on this unit will include Guillain-Barré syndrome, Multiple Sclerosis, Myasthenia Gravis, cervical and lumbar laminectomy, seizure req 48° or less of monitoring, migraines, sub-acute traumatic brain injury and overflow medical or surgical patients.

In addition, the unit will transition from the leadership of Annette Dunphy, Director of Nursing and Christy Morris, Interim – Nurse Manager to Cynthia Trout, Director of Nursing and Amber Gamble, Nurse Manager.
