**Please Include with Your Application:**

1. Current Resume
2. Academic transcript from all universities attended (student copy is acceptable)
3. Personal recommendations: Please use the recommendation form that is part of the Child Life Common Internship Application. We ask that one recommendation come from a professor and one from someone who has observed your work with children.
4. Documentation of 150 hours of work with children in a medical setting (i.e. volunteer, practicum experience, child life assistant). Please use verification form, time sheet, or letter for documentation of hours.
5. Documentation of 150 hours of work with children in a non-healthcare setting (i.e. day care, school, after school, etc.). Please use verification form, time sheet, or letter for documentation of hours.
6. Documentation of 50 hours of work with children in a stressful situation (i.e. camps for children with medical diagnosis, support groups, etc.). Please use verification form, time sheet, or letter for documentation of hours.
7. Documentation of completed Child Life Practicum of at least 100 hours. Please use verification form with Common Application or letter for documentation.
8. Copy of 2019 Eligibility Assessment that is completed by the Association of Child Life Professionals and any required Course in Progress forms for those courses currently in progress.
