Experience life with dementia firsthand. This free community event will give you a chance to know what it's like to have dementia.

Participants will be given a 25-minute slot between 11 a.m.-1 p.m. Besides seeing, hearing and experiencing the world as someone with dementia, you'll have a chance to process your experience with a small group of other participants. Most report increased empathy for those with dementia as a result.
